ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(CARIFESTA WEEKEND) ORDER, 2006

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Carifesta Weekend) Order, 2006.

2. This Order shall have effect from 6.00 a.m. to 10.00 p.m. on the Duration following days:

(a) Friday 29th September, 2006;

(b) Saturday 30th September, 2006; and

(c) Sunday 1st October, 2006.

3. (1) Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

(a) Park Street;

(b) Duke Street, between Frederick Street and Piccadilly Street;

(c) Prince Street, between Frederick Street and Piccadilly Street;

(d) Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Piccadilly Street;

(e) Independence Square North;

(f) Independence Square South;

(g) Piccadilly Street;

(h) Nelson Street, between Independence Square North and Duke Street;

(i) Duncan Street, between Independence Square North and Prince Street;

(j) George Street, between Independence Square North and Duke Street;

- (k) Henry Street, between Independence Square North and Park Street and;
- (l) Frederick Street, between Independence Square North and Park Street.
2. Notwithstanding subclause (1) —
- (a) taxis plying the North Coast route (Maracas/Las Cuevas) shall park on the western side of George Street, between Prince Street and Duke Street;
- (b) taxis plying the Maraval route shall park on the taxi stand on the southern side of Duke Street, between George and Charlotte Streets; and
- (c) taxi plying the Laventille route shall park on the taxi stand on the western side of Nelson Street, between Duke and Prince Streets.
- Road closed 4. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on Charlotte Street between Duke Street and Independence Square North.
- Vehicular traffic route 5. Vehicular traffic proceeding south along Charlotte Street, shall turn west onto Duke Street and then proceed to their respective destinations.
- Taxi routes 6. Taxis that normally ply the Belmont/Gonzales route from Charlotte Street, shall operate from the southern side of Queen Street between Nelson Street and Charlotte Street.
- Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 7. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
