ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(FORMAL OPENING OF THE 2004–2005 LAW TERM OF
THE SUPREME COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD
AND TOBAGO) ORDER, 2004

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Formal Opening of the 2004–2005 Law Term of the Supreme Court of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago) Order, 2004.

2. This Order shall have effect from 6.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. on Duration Thursday 16th September, 2004.

3. (1) Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) St. Vincent Street, between Duke Street and Queen Street;
- (b) Sackville Street, between Richmond Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (c) Abercromby Street, between Queen Street and Duke Street;
- (d) Knox Street, between St. Vincent Street and Frederick Street;
- (e) Edward Street, between Queen Street and Duke Street;
- (f) Hart Street;
- (g) Pembroke Street, between Knox Street and Park Street;
and
- (h) Duke Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street.

Parking prohibited

(2) Notwithstanding clause 3(1) Police and Defence Force vehicles may park on the eastern side of Edward Street, between Queen Street and Sackville Street.

(3) Parking is prohibited on the grounds of the southern and western sides of the Red House.

2660 *Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Formal Opening of the 2004–2005 Law Term of the Supreme Court of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago) Order, 2004*

- Roads closed to vehicular traffic 4. From 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. the following roads shall be closed to vehicular traffic:
- (a) St. Vincent Street, between Duke Street and Queen Street;
 - (b) Hart Street;
 - (c) Abercromby Street, between Park Street and Queen Street; and
 - (d) Knox Street.
- Vehicular routes 5. From 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. vehicular traffic proceeding—
- (a) east along Sackville Street, shall turn north onto Edward Street;
 - (b) west along Duke Street, shall turn north onto Pembroke Street;
 - (c) north along Abercromby Street, shall turn west onto Queen Street; and
 - (d) south on St. Vincent Street, shall turn west onto Duke Street.
- Taxi-stands 6. Taxis that normally ply—
- (a) the St. Ann's route from Hart Street, shall operate from the southern side of Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Henry Street; and
 - (b) the St. James route from Hart Street, shall operate from the northern side of Independence Square North, between Frederick Street and Henry Street.
- Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
Chap. 48:50 7. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
