

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 231

REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE POLICE SERVICE ACT, CHAP. 15:01

NOTIFICATION

NOTICE is hereby given that, pursuant to regulation 4(1) of the Police Service (Recognition of an Appropriate Association) Regulations, 1992 (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”), made under section 24 of the Police Service Act (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”):

- (a) an application for recognition as an appropriate recognized association was made to the Minister of Finance pursuant to regulation 3(1) of the Regulations on the 6th day of February, 2004;
- (b) the name of the applicant is the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service Social and Welfare Association; and
- (c) a copy of the Rules of the association and a list of the names of the members of the association that the association purports to represent and of the class and any category of office into which those members fall, may be examined at the Registrar General’s Department, Registration House, 72–74, South Quay, Port-of-Spain.

And take notice that, pursuant to regulation 4(1)(b) of the Regulations, unless an association objects before the expiry of fourteen days from the date of the publication of this notification, the application shall be determined under section 23(1) of the Act.
