MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(CARNIVAL) (NO. 2) ORDER, 2000

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Carnival) (No. 2) Order, 2000.

PART I

SAN JUAN

2. This Part has effect during the times and on the dates specified in paragraphs 3 and 4.

3. On Sunday 5th, Monday 6th and Tuesday 7th March, 2000, parking is prohibited on the Saddle Road, San Juan between Prizgar Road and Eastern Main Road, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.

4. On Sunday 5th March, 2000, vehicular traffic is prohibited on Saddle Road, between Real Street and Eastern Main Road, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.

5. On Monday 6th March, 2000 and Tuesday 7th March, 2000, parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 9.00 p.m. on the following roads:

- (a) Saddle Road, between Real Street and Eastern Main Road;
- (b) First Avenue, between Eastern Main Road and First Street;
- (c) Colda Tinda Avenue;
- (d) Second Street, between First Avenue and First Street.

PART II

CUREPE

6. This Part has effect between the hours of—
- (a) 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon and 7.00 p.m. on Monday 6th March, 2000; and
  - (b) 11.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on Tuesday 7th March, 2000.

- Vehicular traffic
7. Vehicular traffic shall proceed as follows:
- (a) vehicles proceeding south along Southern Main Road shall be diverted east along Evans Street, south along McDonald Street and return to Southern Main Road by way of the east-to-west streets, except Clifford Street;
  - (b) vehicles proceeding east along Eastern Main Road shall proceed north along Frederick Street, east into Sellier Street and south along Francis Street into Eastern Main Road;
  - (c) vehicles proceeding west along Eastern Main Road shall proceed south into Bellesmythe Street, west into Evans Street, north along Southern Main Road, then west into Eastern Main Road.
- Parking prohibited
8. Parking and waiting are prohibited on Southern Main Road, between Eastern Main Road and Churchill-Roosevelt Highway.

- (a) 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon and 10.00 p.m. on Carnival Monday 6th March, 2000; and
  - (b) 11.00 a.m. and 8.00 p.m. on Tuesday 7th March, 2000.
- Vehicular traffic
10. Vehicular traffic shall proceed as follows:
- (a) vehicles proceeding east along Eastern Main Road shall be diverted north along Auzonville Road, east along Hendrickson Street, east along Connell Street, east on Francis Street, north along Tunapuna Road, east along Green Street, south along El Dorado Road, east along Lackpat Street, south along Kadan Street and east into Eastern Main Road;
  - (b) vehicles proceeding west along Eastern Main Road shall turn south along Macoya Road, west along Churchill-Roosevelt Highway, north along the entrance to the University of the West Indies, west along Watts Trace, north along Evans Street and into Eastern Main Road.
- Parking prohibited
11. Parking is prohibited on—
- (a) Macoya Road;
  - (b) Eastern Main Road, between Caura Royal Road and St. John's Road.

13. Vehicular traffic shall proceed as follows: Vehicular traffic
- (a) vehicles proceeding east along Eastern Main Road shall enter the Priority Bus Route at Five Rivers Junction, exit at Second Crossing and turn east along Eastern Main Road;
  - (b) vehicles proceeding west along Eastern Main Road shall enter the Priority Bus Route at Second Crossing and exit at Five Rivers Junction;
  - (c) vehicles proceeding south on Lopinot Road shall turn west into the Priority Bus Route;
  - (d) vehicles travelling north on Golden Grove Road, shall turn west into Old Golden Grove Road or east into Albert Street.
14. Vehicular Traffic is prohibited as follows: Vehicular traffic prohibited

  - (e) on Royal Promenade, between Albert Street and Eastern Main Road;
  - (f) on Victoria Street, between Albert Street and Eastern Main Road;
  - (g) Trinity Street, between Golden Grove Road and Victoria Street.
15. Parking is prohibited on— Parking prohibited
- (a) Old Golden Grove Road;
  - (b) St. Vincent Street;
  - (c) Waterloo Road, between Eastern Main Road and Albert Street;
  - (d) Lopinot Road, between Eastern Main Road and the Priority Bus Route.

## PART V

## ARIMA

- Duration 16. This Part has effect between the hours of—  
 (a) 2.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon and 10.00 p.m. on Monday 6th March, 2000; and  
 (b) 11.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. on Tuesday, 7th March, 2000.
- Vehicular traffic 17. Vehicular traffic entering Arima shall proceed as follows:  
 (a) from the west, along Eastern Main Road, north into Industry Street, east into Anglican Street, north into King Street, along Sanchez Street and north along Prince Street to El Carmen Street, east along Columbus Street to Moreno Street, into Guanapo Street and into Eastern Main Road;  
 (b) from the east, along Guanapo Street, south into Quesnel Street, continuing west and then south into Pro Queen Street;  
 (c) from the South—  
 (i) along Cocorite Street, west into Quesnel Street; and  
 (ii) along O'Meara Road, east into La Chance Trace, north into Subero Street, east into Koon Koon Street and north along Malabar Road.
- Priority Bus Route maxis 18. Maxi-taxis proceeding east along the Priority Bus Route shall turn north into Railway Road, continuing north into Industry Street, east into Anglican Street, north along King Street, east into Sanchez Street, south into St. Joseph Street and into the Priority Bus Route maxi-taxi stand.
- Main Road maxis 19. Main Road maxi-taxis approaching Arima shall proceed north into Industry Street, east along Anglican Street, north into King Street, east into Rose Street, north into St. Joseph Street and into Main Road maxi-taxi stand.
- Priority Bus Route buses 20. Buses proceeding east along the Priority Bus Route shall turn north into Railway Road, continuing north into Queen Mary Avenue, west on John Shaw Avenue into the stand on the southern side of John Shaw Avenue and face west, in front of the Health Centre.
- Vehicular traffic 21. Vehicles proceeding into the Arima Fire and Police Stations shall do so by way of Green Street and the Police Station's southern gateway, respectively.

- (i) Prince Street, between Broadway and Sorzano Street;
- (j) Raglan Street, between Guanapo Street and Sorzano Street, except that maxi-taxis may park at the maxi-taxi stand on this street;
- (k) Lopez Street.

24. Public Transport Service Corporation buses shall proceed as follows:

Temporary bus routes

- (a) buses approaching Arima from the east along Guanapo Street shall travel west into Quesnel Street, continuing south into Pro Queen Street, west along Wallen Street, north along Railway Road into Queen Mary Avenue and Hollis Avenue, then into the terminus;
- (b) buses proceeding to Sangre Grande shall do so by proceeding north along King Street, east along Sanchez Street, then east along El Carmen Street into Moreno Street, then east into Guanapo Street and into Eastern Main Road;
- (c) buses proceeding to Port-of-Spain shall proceed north along King Street, west along Lopez Street, into Industry Street, then west into Eastern Main Road.

25. Maxi-taxis shall assemble as follows:

Maxi-taxi stands

- (a) Sangre Grande maxi-taxis, on the eastern side of Raglan Street, facing south, between Sorzano Street and Guanapo Street;

- (b) Main Road and Priority Bus Route maxi-taxis, on their respective stands on St. Joseph Street;
- (c) San Rafael, Talparo and Carapo maxi-taxis shall be relocated from De Verteuil Street to Pro De Verteuil Street on the western side, facing south.

Conventional

26. Conventional taxis shall assemble as follows:

- (a) Port-of-Spain conventional taxi stand shall be relocated to the southern side of lower Broadway, between St. Joseph Street and King Street, facing west;
- (b) Mausica Old Road taxis shall be relocated to Broadway, on the southern side, facing west, between King Street and Gordon Street;
- (c) Mt. Pleasant taxis shall be relocated to higher Prince Street, facing north, on the western side, between Sanchez Street and Church Street;
- (d) Calvary Hill taxis shall be relocated to higher Woodford Street, on the western side, facing north, between Sanchez Street and Church Street;
- (e) Cumuto, Sangre Grande and Pinto Road taxi stands shall be relocated to Guanapo Street, facing east, on the northern side, between Raglan Street and Quesnel Street;
- (f) Cocorite Road and La Horquetta taxi stands shall be relocated to Cocorite Road, on the eastern side, facing south, between Maurice Avenue and Quesnel Street;
- (g) Malabar and Carapo taxi stands shall be relocated to Loubon Street, on the southern side, facing west.

## PART VI

### SANGRE GRANDE

Duration

27. This Part has effect between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon and 10.00 p.m. on Monday 6th March, 2000 and 12.00 noon and 11.00 p.m. on Tuesday 7th March, 2000.

28. Vehicular traffic shall proceed as follows:

- (a) vehicles proceeding east along Eastern Main Road shall be diverted north into Ramdass Street, east into Adventist Street, north into Ojoe Road, east into Neil Street, south into Sukhram Street, south into Foster Road, east into River Street, south into Henderson Street, east into Brierley Street and south into Boodooville;

- (b) vehicles proceeding west along Eastern Main Road shall be diverted north into Savi Street, west along Toco Road, north along Henderson Street, west along Brierley Street, north along Foster Road, west along River Street, north along Ojoe Road, west along Adventist Street, south along Picton Road, west along Railway Road, south along Ajim Baksh Road and west along Eastern Main Road;
- (c) vehicles proceeding north along Cunapo Southern Main Road towards Eastern Main Road shall proceed west into Juteram Street, north into Paul Street and west along Eastern Main Road;
- (d) vehicles proceeding into Cunapo Southern Main Road shall proceed south into Paul Street, east into Mary Street and south into Cunapo Southern Main Road.

29. Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) Eastern Main Road, between Picton Road and Savi Street;
- (b) Brierley Street, between Michael Street and Ramdass Street;
- (c) Ramdass Street, between Eastern Main Road and Adventist Street;
- (d) Adventist Street, between Ramdass Street and Ojoe Road;
- (e) Ojoe Road, between Adventist Street and Neil Street;
- (f) Neil Street, between Ojoe Road and Sukhram Street;
- (g) Sukhram Street, between Neil Street and Foster Road;
- (h) Foster Road, between Sukhram Street and Brierley Street;
- (i) River Street, between Ojoe Road and Henderson Street;
- (j) Brierley Street, between Toco Road and Foster Road;
- (k) Ojoe Road, between Brierley Street and Adventist Street;
- (l) Savi Street and Boodooville.

30. Taxis may ply for hire as follows:

Taxis stands

- (a) taxis and maxi-taxis plying for hire from Sangre Grande to Port-of-Spain shall park on the southern side of Brierley Street, facing west, between River Street and Railway Road Extension and shall ply via River Street and River Street Extension Road;
- (b) taxis plying for hire along the Manzanilla/Mayaro and Fishing Pond routes shall park east of the twenty-nine and a half mile mark along Eastern Main Road, facing east, on the northern side of the road;
- (c) taxis plying for hire from Sangre Grande to Matura, Toco and Matelot shall park on the northern side of the Toco Road, east of Brierley Street, facing east;

- (d) taxis plying for hire along the hospital route shall park on the western side of Ojoe Road, between River Street and Mootee Street;
- (e) taxis plying for hire along Foster Road shall park on the western side along Foster Road, north of River Street.

Temporary

31. All Public Transport Service Corporation buses shall use the normal route and exit west on Brierley Street, south into Ramdass Street, then west into Eastern Main Road.

## PART VII

### CHAGUANAS

Duration

32. This Part has effect between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 9.00 p.m. on Monday 6th March, 2000 and 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 midnight on Tuesday 7th March, 2000.

prohibited

33. Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) Chaguanas Main Road, between the intersection of Old Southern Main Road and Endeavour Road and the intersection of Laing Street and Caroni Savannah Road;
- (b) Eleanor Street, between Marc Street and Marie Street;
- (c) Caroni Savannah Road, between Chaguanas Main Road and the Endeavour Link Road;
- (d) Rennie Street, between Caroni Savannah Road and St. Yves Street;
- (e) Rudranath Capildeo Street, between St. Yves Street and Endeavour Road;
- (f) Endeavour Road, between Rudranath Capildeo Street and Chaguanas Main Road;
- (g) Old Southern Main Road, between Eleanor Street and Chaguanas Main Road.

Roads closed

34. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) Chaguanas Main Road, from the intersection of Old Southern Road and Endeavour Road to Caroni Savannah Road;
- (b) Marc Street, between Eleanor Street and Chaguanas Main Road;
- (c) Market Street, between Eleanor Street and Chaguanas Main Road.

35. Vehicular traffic shall proceed as follows: One-way traffic

- (a) along Endeavour Road, between Chaguanas Main Road and Rudranath Capildeo Street, in a southerly direction;
- (b) along Railway Road East, between Laing Street and Chaguanas Main Road, in a southerly direction;
- (c) along Railway Road West, in a northerly direction.

36. Vehicular traffic entering or leaving Chaguanas shall proceed as follows: Vehicular routes

- (a) traffic leaving Chaguanas from the vicinity of the Police Station shall proceed north along Caroni Savannah Road, east into Uriah Butler Highway;
- (b) traffic from Rudranath Capildeo Street to San Fernando and to Montrose shall proceed south into Endeavour Road and then east along Endeavour Road, and north along Mulchan Seuchan Link Road, to Uriah Butler Highway;
- (c) traffic from Rudranath Capildeo Street to Port-of-Spain shall turn into Access Street, then west into Rennie Street and north along Caroni Savannah Road;
- (d) vehicular traffic from Montrose Village and Port-of-Spain shall turn right into Link Road and into the Uriah Butler Highway, west into the Endeavour Link Road and south into Caroni Savannah Road;
- (e) traffic coming from San Fernando shall turn left into Ramsarran Street, left at Jasso corner, into Success Street, east into Chaguanas Main Road, north into Caroni Savannah Road, east into Xavier Street, south into Imamshah Street, left into Rudranath Capildeo Street, north along Rudranath Capildeo Street, east into Endeavour Road and left into Chaguanas Main Road.

37. Public Transport Service Corporation buses from Port-of-Spain shall use the temporary terminus at the entrance to the north-bound carriageway, Uriah Butler Highway from Chaguanas Main Road. Temporary bus terminus

38. Public Transport Service Corporation buses from San Fernando shall travel along Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway up to Chaguanas Main Road, west along Chaguanas Main Road and south on the Old Southern Main Road. Routes for buses from San Fernando temporary bus terminus

## PART VIII

## COUVA
