THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
ZIMBABWE AND PAKISTAN vs. WEST INDIES CRICKET
TEAM ORDER, 2000

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) Zimbabwe and Pakistan vs. West Indies Cricket Team Order, 2000. Citation

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on the following days: Commencement and cessation

Thursday, 16th March, 2000;

Friday, 17th March, 2000;

Saturday, 18th March, 2000;

Sunday, 19th March, 2000;

Monday, 20th March, 2000;

Saturday, 22nd April, 2000; and

Sunday, 23rd April, 2000.

3. Parking of vehicles, is prohibited on the following roads: Parking

(a) Tragarete Road, between Alexandra Street and Serpentine Road;

(b) Havelock Street;

(c) St. Clair Avenue;

(d) Kavanagh Street;

(e) White Street;

(f) the alley-way, between Havelock Street and Broome Street;

(g) the alley-way, between Alexandra Street and Elizabeth Street;

(h) Rosalino Street, between Roberts Street and Tragarete Road;

(i) Pole Carew Street;

- (j) Serpentine Road, between Tragarete Road and Serpentine Place;
- (k) Elizabeth Street, between Tragarete Road and Hayes Street;
- (l) Damian Street; and
- (m) Taylor Street.

Parking
restricted

4. Parking is prohibited as follows:

(a) on the western side of—

- (i) Broome Street;
- (ii) Alexandra Street;
- (iii) Gray Street;
- (iv) Serpentine Place;
- (v) Gallus Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Warren Street;
- (vi) Alberto Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Warren Street;
- (vii) Rosalino Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Warren Street;
- (viii) Luis Street, between Tragarete Road and Roberts Street;
- (ix) Alfredo Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Tragarete Road; and
- (x) Carlos Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Tragarete Road;

(b) on the eastern side of—

- (i) Elizabeth Street, between Hayes Street and Serpentine Road; and
- (ii) Mary Street;

(c) on the southern side of—

- (i) Flood Street;
- (ii) Jackson Street;
- (iii) Hayes Street;
- (iv) Sweet Briar Road, between Elizabeth Street and Alexandra Street;
- (v) Roberts Street, between Damian Street and Murray Street;
- (vi) Hunter Street;
- (vii) Brabrant Street; and
- (viii) Hamilton Holder Street;

(d) on the northern side of—

- (i) Jackson Square North; and
- (ii) Seigert Square North.

5. (1) Vehicular traffic on Havelock Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road, shall proceed in a northerly direction only. One-way traffic

(2) Vehicular traffic on Elizabeth Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road, shall proceed in a southerly direction only.

(3) Vehicular traffic on Rosalino Street, between Tragarete Road and Roberts Street, shall proceed in a southerly direction only.

(4) Vehicular traffic on St. Clair Avenue, between Elizabeth Street and Roxy Roundabout, shall proceed in a westerly direction only.

6. There shall be no right turn:

No right turn

- (a) from Elizabeth Street into Tragarete Road;
- (b) from Sweet Briar Road into Elizabeth Street;
- (c) from Havelock Street into St. Clair Avenue;
- (d) from Kavanagh Street into St. Clair Avenue;
- (e) from Broome Street into St. Clair Avenue.

7. Vehicles shall enter the King George V Car Park by way of the following: Entrance to King George V Car Park

- (a) Northern entrance—vehicles proceeding east along the Western Main Road shall turn north into Serpentine Road and enter the park through the northern entrance;
- (b) South-eastern entrance/South-western entrance—vehicles travelling west on St. Clair Avenue shall enter through the South-eastern entrance/South western entrance;
- (c) Western entrance—vehicles travelling north on Havelock Street, shall enter the park through the south-western entrance.

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
