MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(FORMAL OPENING OF THE 2000–2001 LAW TERM OF  
THE SUPREME COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD  
AND TOBAGO) ORDER, 2000

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Formal Opening of the 2000–2001 Law Term of the Supreme Court of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago) Order, 2000. Citation

2. This Order has effect between 6.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. on Monday 18th September, 2000. Duration

3. Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) St. Vincent Street, between Duke Street and Queen Street;
  - (b) Sackville Street, between Richmond Street and St. Vincent Street;
  - (c) Abercromby Street, between Queen Street and Duke Street;
  - (d) Knox Street, between St. Vincent Street and Frederick Street;
  - (e) Edward Street, between Queen Street and Duke Street;
  - (f) Hart Street;
  - (g) the grounds of the southern and western sides of the Red House;
  - (h) Pembroke Street, between Knox Street and Park Street; and
  - (i) Duke Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street.
- Parking prohibited

4. From 10.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. the following roads shall be closed to vehicular traffic: Roads closed to vehicular traffic

- (a) St. Vincent Street, between Duke Street and Queen Street;
- (b) Hart Street;
- (c) Abercromby Street, between Park Street and Queen Street; and
- (d) Knox Street.

- Vehicular routes      5. From 10.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m., vehicular traffic shall proceed as follows:
- (a) east along Sackville Street, shall turn north into Edward Street;
  - (b) west along Duke Street, shall turn north into Pembroke Street;
  - (c) north along Abercromby Street, shall turn west into Queen Street; and
  - (d) south on St. Vincent Street, shall turn west into Duke Street.
- Taxi-stands      6. Taxis that normally ply—
- (a) the St. Ann’s route from Hart Street, shall operate from the southern side of Queen Street, between Charlotte Street and Henry Street;
  - (b) the St. James route from Hart Street, shall operate from the western side of Henry Street, between Queen Street and Prince Street.
- Parking      7. Parking of vehicles is prohibited on the eastern side of Edward Street, between Queen Street and Sackville Street except for Police and Defence Force vehicles.
- Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked

Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
