NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC  
PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcel of land described in the Schedule and situate at Lot No 2, Constabulary Street, Carenage, in the Ward of Diego Martin in the County of St. George are lands likely to be needed for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: Construction/Expansion of the Carenage Health Centre.

SCHEDULE

Two parcels of land together comprising approximately 906.1 square metres, situate at Lot No. 2, Constabulary Street, Carenage, in the Ward of Diego Martin in the County of St George and detailed as follows:

- (a) a parcel of land comprising approximately 642.6 square metres and said to belong now or formerly to Virginia Julien; and
- (b) a parcel of land comprising approximately 263.5 square metres and said to belong now or formerly to Fred Hillaire.
