MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(STEELBAND PANORAMA) ORDER, 2001

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Steelband Panorama) Order, 2001. Citation

2. This Order has effect on the dates and between the times specified hereunder: Duration

- (a) 11.00 a.m. on Saturday, 10th February, 2001 and 4.00 a.m. on Sunday, 11th February, 2001;
- (b) 9.00 a.m. on Sunday, 11th February, 2001 and 4.00 a.m. on Monday, 12th February, 2001;
- (c) 6.00 p.m. on Thursday, 15th February, 2001 and 2.00 a.m. on Friday, 16th February, 2001;
- (d) 11.00 a.m. on Sunday, 18th February, 2001 and 3.00 a.m. on Monday, 19th February, 2001;
- (e) 5.00 p.m. on Saturday, 24th February, 2001 and 4.00 a.m. on Sunday, 25th February, 2001.

3. On the dates and during the times specified in section 2, no person shall park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain on the following roads: Parking prohibited

- (a) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Stanmore Avenue;
- (b) Chancery Lane;
- (c) Albion Street, between Victoria Avenue and Chancery Lane;
- (d) Pembroke Street, between Keate Street and Gordon Street;
- (e) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Gordon Street;
- (f) Keate Street;
- (g) Queen's Park East, between Jerningham Avenue and Queen's Park West;
- (h) Charlotte Street, between Queen's Park West and New Street;
- (i) Gordon Street, between Charlotte Street and Dundonald Street;

- (j) Victoria Avenue, between Queen's Park West and Albion Street, except for taxis at the Queen's Park Taxi Stand; and
- (k) Dundonald Street, between Melville Lane and Queen's Park West.
- Parking restricted 4. Parking of motor vehicles is restricted on the following roads:
- (a) on Stanmore Avenue, between Queen's Park West and Tranquillity Street—to the western side;
- (b) on Victoria Avenue, between Albion Street and Tragarete Road—to the eastern side; and
- (c) on Dere Street, between Cummins Lane and Melville Lane—to the western side.
- Parking of P.T.S.C. buses 5. Public Transport Service Corporation buses may park on the eastern side of Dundonald Street, south of Melville Lane.
- One-way traffic 6. Vehicular traffic shall proceed—
- (a) on Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane, in a westerly direction only;
- (b) on Chancery Lane, between Keate Street and Queen's Park West, in a northerly direction only; and
- (c) on Albion Street in a westerly direction only.
- Two-way traffic 7. Vehicular traffic may proceed in both directions along Gordon Street, between Chancery Lane and Frederick Street.
- Roads closed 8. The roads listed hereunder are closed to vehicular traffic:
- (a) Frederick Street, between Keate Street and Queen's Park West; and
- (b) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane.
- Traffic prohibited 9. Vehicular traffic is prohibited along Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane, except for vehicles conveying steelband instruments.
- Parking in Queen's Park Savannah 10. Vehicles may be parked in the Queen's Park Savannah in accordance with the direction of police officers on duty.
- Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked 11. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
