MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
CUBA VS TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO AND MEXICO VS
TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO FOOTBALL TEAM ORDER, 2001

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) Cuba vs Trinidad and Tobago and Mexico vs Trinidad and Tobago Football Team Order, 2001. Citation

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 12.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. on the following days: Commencement and cessation

- (a) Saturday 21st April, 2001; and
- (b) Wednesday 25th April, 2001.

3. Parking of vehicles is prohibited on— Parking prohibited

- (a) Tragarete Road, between Alexandra Street and Serpentine Road;
- (b) Havelock Street;
- (c) St. Clair Avenue;
- (d) Kavanagh Street;
- (e) White Street;
- (f) the alley between Havelock Street and Broome Street;
- (g) the alley between Alexandra Street and Elizabeth Street;
- (h) Rosalino Street, between Robert Street and Tragarete Road;
- (i) Pole Carew Street;
- (j) Serpentine Road, between Tragarete Road and Serpentine Place;
- (k) Elizabeth Street, between Tragarete Road and Hayes Street;
- (l) Damian Street; and
- (m) Taylor Street.

Parking
restricted

4. Parking is prohibited as follows:

(a) on the western side of—

- (i) Broome Street;
- (ii) Alexandra Street;
- (iii) Gray Street;
- (iv) Serpentine Place;
- (v) Gallus Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Warren Street;
- (vi) Alberto Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Warren Street;
- (vii) Rosalino Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Warren Street;
- (viii) Luis Street, between Tragarete Road and Robert Street;
- (ix) Alfredo Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Tragarete Road; and
- (x) Carlos Street, between Ariapita Avenue and Tragarete Road;

(b) on the eastern side of—

- (i) Elizabeth Street, between Hayes Street and Serpentine Road; and
- (ii) Mary Street;

(c) on the southern side of—

- (i) Flood Street;
- (ii) Jackson Square;
- (iii) Hayes Street;
- (iv) Sweet Briar Road, between Elizabeth Street and Alexandra Street;
- (v) Robert Street, between Damian Street and Murray Street;
- (vi) Hunter Street;
- (vii) Brabrant Street; and
- (viii) Hamilton Holder Street; and

(d) on the northern side of—

- (i) Jackson Square North; and
- (ii) Seigert Square North.

5. (1) Vehicular traffic on— One-way traffic
- (a) Elizabeth Street, between St. Clair Avenue and Tragarete Road, shall proceed in a southerly direction only;
 - (b) Rosalino Street, between Tragarete Road and Robert Street, shall proceed in a northerly direction only and turn left on Tragarete Road; and
 - (c) St. Clair Avenue, between Elizabeth Street and Roxy Roundabout, shall proceed in an easterly direction only.
6. There shall be no right turn from— No right turn
- (a) Elizabeth Street onto Tragarete Road; and
 - (b) Sweet Briar Road onto Elizabeth Street;
7. There shall be no left turn from— No left turn
- (a) Kavanagh Street onto St. Clair Avenue; and
 - (b) from Broome Street onto St. Clair Avenue.
8. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on Havelock Street, between Tragarete Road and St. Clair Avenue. Vehicular traffic prohibited
9. Vehicles shall enter the King George V Car Park (“the Car Park”) as follows: Entrance to King George V Car Park
- (a) vehicles proceeding east along Western Main Road, shall turn north onto Serpentine Road and enter the Car Park through the northern entrance; and
 - (b) vehicles proceeding east along St. Clair Avenue shall enter through the south-eastern or south-western entrance.
10. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
