MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 41 OF THE FREEDOM OF  
INFORMATION ACT

THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION  
(PUBLICATION OF ARRANGEMENTS) REGULATIONS, 2001

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Freedom of Information <sup>Citation</sup>  
(Publication of Arrangements) Regulations, 2001.

2. In these Regulations—

“Act” means the Freedom of Information Act;

“arrangements” means the arrangements referred to in section  
22(1) of the Act;

“decision-maker” means a person referred to in section 22(1) of  
the Act; and

“publication” includes the subsequent publication of an  
amendment of the arrangements.

3. (1) Where, in compliance with section 22 of the Act, a public <sup>Publication of  
arrangement</sup> authority makes arrangements identifying the scope of authority exercised by the decision-maker in respect of a decision to be made concerning an application under the Act, the public authority shall—

(a) notify the Minister; and

(b) publish the details of the arrangements by a notice in the  
*Gazette* and in a daily newspaper circulating in Trinidad  
and Tobago.

(2) The notice referred to in subregulation (1) shall contain—

(a) the name, designation and contact number of the decision-  
maker within the public authority;

(b) a brief description of the level of decisions that the decision-  
maker is authorized to make in accordance with the  
arrangements; and

(c) the location within the public authority where the arrangements can be examined.
