MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE  
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO THIRTY-NINTH  
ANNIVERSARY OF INDEPENDENCE CELEBRATIONS)  
ORDER, 2001

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Republic of Trinidad and Tobago Thirty-Ninth Anniversary of Independence Celebrations) Order, 2001.

2. This Order has effect from 6.00 a.m. on Friday 31st August, 2001 to 1.00 a.m. on Saturday 1st September, 2001.

3. (1) Parking is prohibited—

Parking  
prohibited

(a) between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. on—

- (i) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Cipriani Boulevard;
- (ii) Chancery Lane, between Keate Street and Queen's Park West;
- (iii) Dere Street;
- (iv) Albion Street;
- (v) Gordon Street; and
- (vi) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Park Street;

(b) between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m. on Park Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street;

(c) between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on—

- (i) Western Main Road, from its junction with Tragarete Road and its junction with Long Circular Road;
- (ii) Tragarete Road;

(d) between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. on Long Circular Road, between Western Main Road and Patna Street;

- (e) from 12.00 noon on Friday 31st August, 2001 to 1.00 a.m. on Saturday 1st September, 2001 on—
- (i) Queen's Park West, from Chancery Lane to Queen's Royal College Roundabout;
  - (ii) Maraval Road, from Queen's Royal College Roundabout to St. Clair Roundabout;
  - (iii) Circular Road, from St. Clair Roundabout to St. Ann's Roundabout;
  - (iv) Queen's Park East, from St. Ann's Roundabout to Queen's Park West; and
  - (v) Charlotte Street, from Queen's Park West to New Street.

(2) Notwithstanding subparagraph (1), taxi drivers operating their taxis for hire may park their taxis in the taxi stand on the western side of Dere Street.

Vehicular  
traffic  
prohibited

4. Vehicular traffic is prohibited—

- (a) between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m.—
- (i) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane;
  - (ii) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Abercromby Street;
  - (iii) Frederick Street, between Charlotte Street and Abercromby Street; and
  - (iv) Pembroke Street, between Keate Street and Gordon Street;
- (b) between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m. on Park Street, between Henry Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (c) between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Tragarete Road;
- (d) between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Western Main Road, between Damian Street and Lucknow Street.

Entry into  
Savannah

5. Motorists shall enter the Queen's Park Savannah—

- (a) through the entrance opposite Whitehall, if the vehicle—
- (i) forms part of the Independence Anniversary Parade; and
  - (ii) belongs to either the Defence Force, the Police Service, the Fire Service or a voluntary organisation;

(b) through the entrance opposite Frederick Street, if the vehicle is being used to transport personnel of the Defence Force, the Police Service, the Fire Service or a voluntary organisation.

6. Motorists may between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m. <sup>Parking</sup> park their vehicles on the Queen's Park Savannah, south of the Grand <sup>Queen's Park Savannah</sup> Stand as directed by Police Officers on duty.

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the <sup>Removal of</sup> commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in <sup>vehicles</sup> contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and <sup>unlawfully</sup> impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the <sup>parked</sup> Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
