MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(FORMAL OPENING OF THE 2002–2003 LAW TERM OF
THE SUPREME COURT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD
AND TOBAGO) ORDER, 2002

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Formal Opening of the 2002–2003 Law Term of the Supreme Court of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago) Order, 2002.

2. This Order shall have effect between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. on Monday 16th September, 2002.

3. (1) Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) St. Vincent Street, Duke Street and Queen Street;
- (b) Sackville Street, between Richmond Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (c) Abercromby Street, between Queen Street and Duke Street;
- (d) Knox Street, between St. Vincent Street and Frederick Street;
- (e) Edward Street, between Queen Street and Duke Street;
- (f) Hart Street;
- (g) Pembroke Street, between Knox Street and Park Street;
and
- (h) Duke Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street.

Parking
prohibited

(2) Parking is prohibited on the grounds of the southern and western sides of the Red House.

(3) Parking of vehicles is prohibited on the eastern side of Edward Street, between Queen Street and Sackville Street.

(4) Subsection (3) shall not apply to Defence Force vehicles.

- Roads closed to vehicular traffic 4. From the hours of 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. the following roads shall be closed to vehicular traffic:
- (a) St. Vincent Street between Duke Street and Queen Street;
 - (b) Hart Street;
 - (c) Abercromby Street between Park Street and Queen Street; and
 - (d) Knox Street.
- Vehicular Routes 5. From the hours of 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. vehicular traffic proceeding:
- (a) east along Sackville Street, shall turn north into Edward Street;
 - (b) west along Duke Street, shall turn north into Pembroke Street;
 - (c) north along Abercromby Street, shall turn west into Queen Street; and
 - (d) south on St. Vincent Street, shall turn west into Duke Street.
- Taxi-stands 6. Taxis that normally ply—
- (a) the St. Ann's route from Hart Street, shall operate from the southern side of Queen Street, between Charlotte Street and Henry Street; and
 - (b) the St. James route from Hart Street, shall operate from the western side of Henry Street, between Queen Street and Prince Street.
- Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
Chap. 48:50 7. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
