MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(TRADITIONAL PAN-AROUND-THE-NECK PRELIMINARIES
PANORAMA) ORDER, 1996

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Traditional Pan-around-the-neck Preliminaries Panorama) Order, 1996. Citation

2. This Order has effect between the hours of 5.00 p.m. on Friday, 2nd February, 1996 and 2.00 a.m. on Saturday, 3rd February, 1996. Duration

3. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on the following roads: Parking and vehicular traffic prohibited

- (a) Broadway, between Beetham Highway and Cipriani Circle;
- (b) South Quay, between Duncan Street and Wrightson Road, except for taxis specified at paragraph 7(d), (e) and (f);
- (c) Independence Square South, between George Street and Wrightson Road;
- (d) Independence Square North, between Charlotte Street and Wrightson Road;
- (e) Frederick Street, between Hart Street and Independence Square North;
- (f) Queen Street, between Henry Street and Edward Street;
- (g) St. Vincent Street, between Sackville Street and South Quay;
- (h) Abercromby Street, between Hart Street and South Quay;
- (i) Chacon Street.

4. Notwithstanding paragraph 3(a), vehicles conveying steel pans may park on Broadway, between Beetham Highway and South Quay. Parking restricted

5. Vehicular traffic shall proceed as follows:

- (a) vehicles proceeding south along Frederick Street shall turn east into Prince Street, except taxis plying for hire on Hart Street;
- (b) vehicles proceeding east along Wrightson Road shall not enter Independence Square North;
- (c) vehicles proceeding south along Richmond Street shall turn right at London Street;
- (d) vehicles proceeding south along St. Vincent Street shall turn west into Sackville Street;
- (e) vehicles proceeding west along Independence Square South, shall turn north into George Street;
- (f) vehicles proceeding west along South Quay shall turn north into Duncan Street.

No right turn

6. No vehicle proceeding north along Edward Street shall turn right into Sackville Street save for police vehicles entering Police Headquarters.

Taxi stands

7. Taxis shall operate as follows:

- (a) taxis plying for hire on Chacon Street and Abercromby Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall ply for hire on the northern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road and the entrance to the Port Authority;
- (b) taxis plying for hire on Independence Square North, between Henry Street and Charlotte Street, shall ply for hire as follows:
 - (i) San Fernando taxis shall ply for hire from the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway west of Broadway, facing east;
 - (ii) Chaguanas taxis shall ply for hire from the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway, east of Broadway, facing east;
- (c) taxis plying for hire on the southern side of Independence Square North, between Abercromby Street and St. Vincent Street, and the eastern and western sides of Cipriani Circle, shall ply for hire on the northern side of South Quay, between Charlotte Street and Nelson Street, facing east;

- (d) taxis plying for hire on Henry Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall ply for hire on George Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, facing south;
- (e) taxis plying for hire on Independence Square South, between George Street and Charlotte Street, shall ply for hire on the western side of Nelson Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, facing south;
- (f) taxis plying for hire on Independence Square South, between Charlotte Street and George Street, shall ply for hire on the eastern side of Nelson Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, facing south.

8. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
