MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(PRE-CARNIVAL) ORDER, 1996

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Pre-Carnival) Order, 1996. Citation

2. Notwithstanding any written law to the contrary, motorists attending any pre-carnival functions at the Grand Stand may park their vehicles on the Queen's Park Savannah during the period commencing three hours before the start of the function and ending three hours after the close of the function. Parking of vehicles on Queen's Park Savannah

QUEEN'S PARK SAVANNAH

3. (1) This paragraph has effect between the hours of— Parking prohibited
- (a) 10.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on Saturday, 10th February, 1996;
 - (b) 5.00 p.m. on Tuesday, 13th February, 1996, and 2.00 a.m. on Wednesday, 14th February, 1996;
 - (c) 6.00 p.m. on Friday, 16th February, 1996, and 2.00 a.m. on Saturday, 17th February, 1996;
 - (d) 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Saturday, 17th February, 1996;
 - (e) 5.00 p.m. on Sunday, 18th February, 1996, and 2.00 a.m. on Monday, 19th February, 1996.
- (2) Parking is prohibited on the following roads:
- (a) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Stanmore Avenue, except for taxis plying for hire at the Taxi Stand;
 - (b) Chancery Lane;
 - (c) Albion Street, between Stanmore Avenue and Chancery Lane;
 - (d) Dundonald Street, between Queen's Park West and Albion Street;

- (e) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
 - (f) Keate Street;
 - (g) Frederick Street, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West.
- (3) Parking is permitted on the following roads:
- (a) Stanmore Avenue, between Tranquillity Street and Queen's Park West—on the western side;
 - (b) Victoria Avenue, between Tranquillity Street and Queen's Park West—on the western side;
 - (c) Cipriani Boulevard—on the eastern side;
 - (d) Cummins Lane—on the southern side;
 - (e) Tranquillity Street—on the southern side;
 - (f) Dere Street—on the western side;
 - (g) Dundonald Street—on the eastern side, south of Melville Lane;
 - (h) Dundonald Street—on the eastern side, north of Melville Lane for Public Transport Service Corporation buses only.

- Duration** 4. Paragraphs 5 to 7 have effect between the hours of 12.00 noon and 7.00 p.m. on Sunday, 11th February, 1996.
- Parking and vehicular traffic prohibited** 5. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on the following roads:
- (a) Western Main Road, between Roxy Roundabout and George Cabral Street;
 - (b) all streets intersecting with Western Main Road, between Roxy Roundabout and George Cabral Street.
- Alternative route** 6. Motorists proceeding—
- (a) west along Western Main Road, shall turn south into Damian Street, into Mucurapo Road;
 - (b) east along Western Main Road, shall turn north into George Cabral Street, east into Kathleen Street, then into Delhi Street and into Barbados Road.
- Parking prohibited** 7. Parking is prohibited on the following roads:
- (a) Damian Street;
 - (b) Long Circular Road, between Delhi Street and Western Main Road;

8. Paragraphs 9 to 13 have effect on Saturday, 17th February, 1996. Duration

9. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on the following roads: Parking and

- (a) Knox Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;
- (b) Hart Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street;
- (c) Abercromby Street, between South Quay and Queen Street;
- (d) Independence Square North, between Richmond Street and Charlotte Street;
- (e) Independence Square South, between Charlotte Street and Edward Street;
- (f) Broadway, between South Quay and Independence Square South;
- (g) Frederick Street;
- (h) Queen Street, between Henry Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (i) Duke Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (j) Park Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (k) Oxford Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (l) New Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (m) Gordon Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (n) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Pembroke Street;
- (o) Duprey Drive;
- (p) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane.

10. Parking is prohibited from 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on the following roads: Parking
prohibited

- (a) Chancery Lane;
- (b) Albion Street, between Chancery Lane and Victoria Avenue;
- (c) Dundonald Street, between Queen's Park West and New Street.

11. Vehicular traffic shall proceed between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. as follows: One-way
traffic

- (a) on Keate Street, between Pembroke Street and Chancery Lane—in a westerly direction;
- (b) on Chancery Lane—in a northerly direction;
- (c) on Gordon Street, between Pembroke Street and St. Vincent Street—in a westerly direction;

- (d) on Gordon Street, between Henry Street and Charlotte Street—in an easterly direction;
- (e) on Albion Street—in a westerly direction;
- (f) on Charlotte Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay—in a southerly direction.

Two-way
traffic

12. Notwithstanding any written law to the contrary, vehicular traffic may, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. proceed in both directions—

- (a) around the Queen's Park Savannah, between Marli Street and Queen's Park East, by way of Circular Road;
- (b) on Charlotte Street, between Keate Street and Queen's Park East.

Taxi stands

13. Taxis shall operate as follows:

- (a) St. Ann's taxis that normally ply for hire on Hart Street, shall ply for hire on the southern side of Queen Street, between Charlotte Street and Henry Street;
- (b) St. James taxis that normally ply for hire on Hart Street, shall ply for hire on the western side of Henry Street, between Queen Street and Prince Street;
- (c) taxis that normally ply for hire on the southern side of Independence Square North, between Abercromby Street and St. Vincent Street, and on the eastern and western sides of Cipriani Circle, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South, shall ply for hire on the northern side of South Quay, between Charlotte Street and Nelson Street;
- (d) taxis that normally ply for hire on Independence Square North, between Charlotte Street and Henry Street, shall ply for hire as follows:
 - (i) San Fernando taxis—from the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway west of Broadway, facing east;
 - (ii) Chaguanas taxis—from the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway east of Broadway, facing east;
- (e) taxis that normally ply for hire on Independence Square South, between Charlotte Street and George Street, shall ply for hire on the western side of Nelson Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, facing south;
- (f) taxis that normally ply for hire on Independence Square North, between Charlotte Street and George Street, shall ply for hire on the eastern side of Nelson Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, facing south;

- (g) taxis that normally ply for hire on Chacon Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall ply for hire on the northern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road and the entrance to the Port Authority;
- (h) taxis that normally ply for hire on Abercromby Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall ply for hire on the southern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road and the entrance to the Port Authority;
- (i) taxis that normally ply for hire on Henry Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall ply for hire on the western side of George Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, facing south.

PRE-CARNIVAL FUNCTIONS AT SOUTH QUAY, PORT-OF-SPAIN

14. Paragraphs 15 to 16 have effect between the hours of 10.00 a.m. Duration and 10.00 p.m. on Sunday, 11th February, 1996 and 11.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on Sunday, 18th February, 1996.

15. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on the following roads: Parking and vehicular traffic prohibited

- (a) St. Vincent Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay;
- (b) Abercromby Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay;
- (c) Chacon Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay;
- (d) Broadway, between Beetham Highway and Independence Square South;
- (e) South Quay, between St. Vincent Street and George Street.

16. Taxis shall operate as follows:

Taxi stands

- (a) taxis that normally ply for hire on Chacon Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay shall ply for hire on the northern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road and the entrance to the Port Authority;
- (b) taxis that normally ply for hire on Abercromby Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall ply for hire on the southern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road and the entrance to the Port Authority.

Removal and

17. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
