ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(CARNIVAL) ORDER, 1996

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Carnival) Order, 1996.

2. Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, motorists attending the Parade of Bands at the Grand Stand may park their vehicles on the Queen's Park Savannah, during the period commencing three hours before the start of the function and ending three hours after the closure of the function.

PART I

PORT-OF-SPAIN

3. On Monday, 19th February, 1996, parking is prohibited on the undermentioned roads and all roads lying within and bounded by the said undermentioned roads, between the hours of 12.00 midnight on Sunday, 18th February, 1996 and 9.00 p.m. on Monday, 19th February, 1996, and vehicular traffic is prohibited between the hours of 1.00 a.m. and 9.00 p.m. on Monday, 19th February, 1996:

- (c) South Quay, between Henry Street and Duncan Street with the exception of the taxis specified at paragraph 7(c);
- (d) Queen Street, between Duncan Street and Piccadilly Street;
- (e) Oxford Street;
- (f) Broadway, between South Quay and Beetham Highway;
- (g) Stone Street.

5. During the times and on the dates specified in paragraph 3, vehicular traffic shall proceed as follows:

- (a) Queen Street, between Duncan Street and Piccadilly Street—in an easterly direction;
- (b) Piccadilly Street, between Park Street and Prince Street—in a southerly direction;
- (c) Stone Street, between Wrightson Road and Park Street—in a southerly direction.

6. During the times and on the dates specified in paragraph 3, vehicular traffic shall proceed in both directions along Piccadilly Street, between Prince Street and Queen Street.

7. From 1.00 a.m. on Monday, 19th February, 1996, to 12.00 ^{Taxi-stands} midnight on Tuesday, 20th February, 1996, taxis shall operate as follows:

- (a) taxis assigned to the taxi stand on Chacon Street between Independence Square South and South Quay (Long Circular/Wrightson Road) shall operate from the northern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road and entrance to Port Authority;
- (b) taxis assigned to the taxi stand on Abercromby Street between Independence Square South and South Quay (Diego Martin/Petit Valley) shall operate from the southern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road and entrance to Port Authority;
- (c) taxis assigned to the taxi stand on the southern side of Independence Square North between Abercromby Street and St. Vincent Street, and the eastern and western sides of Cipriani Circle, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South (on call taxis), shall operate from the northern side of South Quay between Charlotte Street and Nelson Street;
- (d) taxis assigned to the taxi stand on Independence Square North between Charlotte Street and Henry Street (San Fernando/Chaguanas) shall operate—
 - (i) San Fernando—from the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway—west of Broadway facing east;
 - (ii) Chaguanas—from the northern carriageway of the Beetham Highway—east of Broadway facing east;
- (e) taxis assigned to the taxi stand on Henry Street between Independence Square South and South Quay, (Tunapuna/Arima/Sangre Grande), shall operate on Charlotte Street between Independence Square South and South Quay—facing south, entering and leaving by way of South Quay;
- (f) taxis assigned to the taxi stand on Independence Square South between Charlotte Street and George Street, (San Juan). shall operate from the western side of George Street between Independence Square South and South Quay facing south entering by way of South Quay;
- (g) taxis assigned to the taxis stand on Independence Square North between Charlotte Street and George Street (Round the Road), shall operate from the eastern side of George Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay facing south, entering and leaving by way of South Quay;

- (h) Route 1 maxi-taxi (Yellow Band) shall enter the maxi-taxi stand on South Quay by way of the Beetham Highway and exit by way of South Quay on the southern side, forty metres east of the Beetham Highway.

11. (1) During the times and on the dates specified in paragraph ^{Two-way traffic} 8(1), vehicular traffic shall proceed in both directions along Piccadilly Street, between Prince Street and Queen Street.

(2) Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, from 12.00 midnight on Sunday, 18th February, 1996 to 6.00 a.m. on Wednesday, 21st February, 1996, vehicular traffic may proceed in both directions around the Queen's Park Savannah, between Cadiz Road and Maraval Road by way of Circular Road.

12. From 1.00 a.m. on Monday, 19th February, 1996, to 12.00 ^{Taxi stand} midnight on Tuesday, 20th February, 1996, taxis assigned to the taxi stand on Victoria Avenue shall operate from Cummins Lane.

- (b) from the west—Circular Road, Queen's Park East, Belmont Circular Road entering the Hospital by way of the mortuary entrance or the main entrance on Belmont Circular Road.

- (d) buses leaving the bus terminus shall use the same route taken to enter from Claude Noel Highway.

PART XVIII

GENERAL

Automatic traffic lights 94. Automatic traffic light signals in the Cities of Port-of-Spain and San Fernando and the Boroughs of Arima and Point Fortin shall not be in operation from 12.00 midnight on Sunday, 18th February, 1996 to 12.00 midnight on Tuesday, 20th February, 1996.

Removal and impounding of vehicles 95. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
