| Citation           | 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Independence Anniversary) (Steelband Street Parade) Order, 1996.  |
| Duration           | 2. This Order has effect between the hours of 4.00 p.m. on Saturday, 31st August, 1996 and 1.00 a.m. on Sunday, 1st September, 1996.  |
| Parking Prohibited | 3. Subject to paragraph 5, parking is prohibited on the following roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(a) Frederick Street, between Queen Street and Queen's Park West;</li> <li>(b) Hart Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street;</li> <li>(c) the pitch portion of the Frederick Street entrance to the Queen's Park Savannah;</li> <li>(d) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Abercromby Street;</li> <li>(e) Gordon Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street;</li> <li>(f) New Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;</li> <li>(g) Oxford Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street;</li> <li>(h) Park Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;</li> <li>(i) Duke Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street;</li> <li>(j) Knox Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;</li> <li>(k) Charlotte Street, between Oxford Street and Queen's Park East;</li> <li>(l) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Maraval Road;</li> </ol> |

- (m) Maraval Road, between Queen's Park West and Circular Road;
- (n) Circular Road; and
- (o) Queen's Park East.

4. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) Frederick Street, between Queen Street and Queen's Park West;
- (b) Hart Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street;
- (c) the pitch portion of the Frederick Street entrance to the Queen's Park Savannah;
- (d) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Abercromby Street;
- (e) Gordon Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street;
- (f) New Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;
- (g) Oxford Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street;
- (h) Park Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;
- (i) Knox Street, between Pembroke Street and Frederick Street;
- (j) Duke Street, between Henry Street and Frederick Street.

5. Vehicles conveying steelband instruments may park on Hart Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street, entering and leaving Hart Street by way of Abercromby Street.

6. Notwithstanding any written law to the contrary, vehicular traffic may, between 4.00 p.m. and 12.00 midnight on Saturday, 31st August, 1996, proceed in both directions—

- (a) around the Queen's Park Savannah, between St. Clair Roundabout and Queen's Park East by way of Circular Road; and
- (b) on Charlotte Street, between Keate Street and Queen's Park East.

7. Taxis plying—

Taxi-stands

- (a) the St. Ann's route from Hart Street, shall operate from the southern side of Queen Street, between Frederick Street and Abercromby Street;

(b) the St. James route from Hart Street, shall operate from the northern side of Duke Street, between Pembroke Street and Abercromby Street.

8. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
