ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF  
THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)  
(PRE-CARNIVAL) ORDER, 1995

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Pre-Carnival) Order, 1995.

2. Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, motorists attending any pre-carnival functions at the Grand Stand may park their vehicles on the Queen's Park Savannah during the period commencing three hours before the start of the function and ending three hours after the close of the function.

PRE-CARNIVAL FUNCTIONS AT THE GRAND STAND  
QUEEN'S PARK SAVANNAH

3. Between the hours of—

- 10.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. on Saturday, 18th February, 1995;
- 9.00 a.m. on Sunday, 19th February, 1995 to 2.00 a.m. on Monday, 20th February, 1995;
- 5.30 p.m. on Tuesday, 21st February, 1995 to 2.00 a.m. on Wednesday, 22nd February, 1995;
- 6.00 p.m. on Friday, 24th February, 1995 to 2.00 a.m. on Saturday, 25th February, 1995;
- 6.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. on Saturday, 25th February, 1995;
- 5.00 p.m. on Sunday, 26th February, 1995 to 2.00 a.m. on Monday, 27th February, 1995—

Parking  
prohibited

(a) parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (i) Queen's Park West except for taxis plying for hire at the Princes Building Taxi Stand, between Queen's Park East and Stanmore Avenue;
- (ii) Chancery Lane;
- (iii) Albion Street, between Stanmore Avenue and Chancery Lane;

- (iv) Dundonald Street, between Queen's Park West and Albion Street;
  - (v) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
  - (vi) Keate Street;
  - (vii) Frederick Street, between Gordon Street and Queen's Park West;
- (b) parking is permitted on the following roads:
- (i) Stanmore Avenue, between Tranquillity Street and Queen's Park West—on the western side;
  - (ii) Victoria Avenue, between Tranquillity Street and Queen's Park West—on the western side, except for Public Transport Service Corporation buses which may park on the eastern side between Albion Street and Queen's Park West, facing south;
  - (iii) Cipriani Boulevard—on the eastern side;
  - (iv) Cummins Lane—on the southern side;
  - (v) Tranquillity Street—on the southern side;
  - (vi) Dere Street—on the western side.

#### ST. JAMES CHILDREN'S CARNIVAL

- Duration 4. Paragraphs 5 to 7 shall have effect between the hours of 12.00 noon and 7.00 p.m. on Sunday, 19th February, 1995.
- Roads closed parking prohibited 5. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on the following roads:
- (a) Western Main Road, between Long Circular Road and George Cabral Street;
  - (b) all streets intersecting with Western Main Road, between Long Circular Road and George Cabral Street will be closed to vehicular traffic.
- Alternative route 6. Motorists proceeding—
- (a) west along Western Main Road, shall turn north into Long Circular Road, west into Delhi Street, then into Kathleen Street and south into George Cabral Street, re-entering Western Main Road;
  - (b) east along Western Main Road, shall turn north into George Cabral Street, east into Kathleen Street, then into Delhi Street and south into long Circular Road, re-entering Western Main Road.

7. Parking is prohibited on the following roads:

- (a) Long Circular Road, between Delhi Street and Western Main Road;
- (b) George Cabral Street, between Kathleen Street and Western Main Road;
- (c) Western Main Road, between Coronation Street and Roxy Roundabout;
- (d) Kathleen Street;
- (e) Delhi Street.

8. Paragraphs 9 to 13 shall have effect on Saturday, 25th February, 1995. Duration

9. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on the following roads: Roads closed parking prohibited

- (a) Knox Street;
- (b) Hart Street;
- (c) Abercromby Street, between South Quay and Knox Street;
- (d) Independence Square North, between St. Vincent Street and Charlotte Street;
- (e) Charlotte Street, between Independence Square North and South Quay;
- (f) George Street, between Independence Square North and South Quay;
- (g) Independence Square South, between George Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (h) Broadway, between South Quay and Independence Square South;
- (i) Frederick Street;
- (j) Queen Street, between Henry Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (k) Duke Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (l) Park Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (m) Oxford Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (n) New Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (o) Gordon Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (p) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Pembroke Street;
- (q) Duprey Drive;
- (r) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane.

Parking

10. Parking is prohibited from 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on the following roads:

- (a) Chancery Lane;
- (b) Albion Street, between Chancery Lane and Victoria Avenue.

One-way  
traffic

11. Vehicular traffic shall proceed between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. as follows:

- (a) on Keate Street, between Pembroke Street and Chancery Lane—in a westerly direction;
- (b) on Chancery Lane—in a northerly direction;
- (c) on Gordon Street, between Pembroke Street and St. Vincent Street—in a westerly direction;
- (d) on Gordon Street, between Henry Street and Charlotte Street—in an easterly direction;
- (e) on Albion Street—in a westerly direction;
- (f) on Charlotte Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay—in a southerly direction.

Two-way  
traffic

12. Notwithstanding any enactment to the contrary, vehicular traffic may, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 7.00 p.m., proceed in both directions—

- (a) around the Queen's Park Savannah, between Marli Street and Queen's Park East, by way of Circular Road;
- (b) on Charlotte Street, between Keate Street and Queen's Park East.

Taxi stands

13. Taxis shall operate as follows:

- (a) St. Ann's taxis plying for hire on Hart Street, shall ply for hire on the southern side of Queen Street, between Charlotte Street and Henry Street;
- (b) St. James taxis plying for hire on Hart Street, shall ply for hire on the western side of Henry Street, between Queen Street and Prince Street;
- (c) taxis that ply for hire on Cipriani Circle shall ply for hire on the northern side of South Quay, between Chacon Street and Broadway;
- (d) San Fernando/Chaguanas taxis plying for hire on the northern side of Independence Square North, between Charlotte Street and Henry Street, shall ply for hire on the southern side of Independence Square North, from a point five metres east of George Street to a point five metres west of Nelson Street;

- (e) La Horquetta/Sangre Grande maxi-taxis plying for hire on Broadway, between South Quay and Independence Square South, shall ply for hire on the northern side of the northern carriageway of Beetham Highway from a point five metres east of Broadway and continuing;
- (f) Arima/Maloney maxi-taxis plying for hire on Broadway, between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall ply for hire on the southern side of South Quay from a point five metres east of Broadway and continuing;
- (g) maxi-taxis plying for hire on Charlotte Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall ply for hire on the northern side of South Quay from a point five metres east of Nelson Street to a point five metres west of Piccadilly Street;
- (h) Chaguanas round the road taxis plying for hire on the southern side of Independence Square North, between Charlotte Street and George Street, shall ply for hire on the northern side of Independence Square South from a point five metres east of Nelson Street to a point five metres west of Duncan Street;
- (i) San Juan taxis plying for hire on the southern side of Independence Square South, between George Street and Charlotte Street, shall ply for hire on the northern side of South Quay, between George Street and Charlotte Street.

PRE-CARNIVAL FUNCTIONS AT INDEPENDENCE SQUARE, PORT-OF-SPAIN

14. Paragraphs 13 to 14 shall have effect between the hours of 7.00 <sup>Duration</sup> a.m. to 7.00 p.m. on Sunday, 19th February, 1995 and 11.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. on Sunday, 26th February, 1995.

15. Parking and vehicular traffic are prohibited on the following <sup>Roads closed</sup> roads: <sup>parking</sup> <sup>prohibited</sup>

- (a) Independence Square North, between St. Vincent Street and Charlotte Street;
- (b) Cipriani Circle;
- (c) Chacon Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square South;
- (d) Frederick Street, between Queen Street and Independence Square South;
- (e) Henry Street, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South;
- (f) George Street, between South Quay and Independence Square South;
- (g) Broadway, between South Quay and Independence Square South;

- (h) Charlotte Street, between South Quay and Independence Square South;
- (i) Independence Square South, between Nelson Street and Chacon Street.

16. Vehicular traffic proceeding south along Charlotte Street, shall turn east into Independence Square North.

Taxi stands

17. Taxis shall operate as follows:

- (a) taxis that ply for hire on Cipriani Circle, shall ply for hire from the northern side of South Quay, between Chacon Street and Broadway;
- (b) San Fernando/Chaguanas taxis plying for hire on the southern side of Independence Square North, between Charlotte Street and Henry Street, shall ply for hire on the southern side of Independence Square North, from a point five metres east of George Street to a point five metres west of Nelson Street;
- (c) La Horquetta/Sangre Grande maxi-taxis plying for hire on Broadway, between South Quay and Independence Square South, shall ply for hire on the northern side of the northern carriageway of Beetham Highway from a point five metres east of Broadway and continuing;
- (d) Arima/Maloney maxi-taxis plying for hire on Broadway, between South Quay and Independence Square South, shall ply for hire on the southern side of South Quay from a point five metres east of Broadway and continuing;
- (e) maxi-taxis plying for hire on Charlotte Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall ply for hire on the northern side of South Quay from a point five metres east of Nelson Street to a point five metres west of Piccadilly Street;
- (f) Chaguanas round the road taxis plying for hire on the southern side of Independence Square North, between Charlotte Street and George Street, shall ply for hire on the northern side of Independence Square South from a point five metres east of Nelson Street to a point five metres west of Duncan Street;
- (g) San Juan taxis plying for hire on the southern side of Independence Square South, between George Street and Charlotte Street, shall ply for hire on the northern side of South Quay, between George Street and Charlotte Street.

18. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
