ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (ARIMA
BOROUGH DAY MILITARY PARADE) ORDER, 2017

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Arima Borough Day Military Parade) Order, 2017.
2. This Order has effect from 8.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight on Duration Sunday 6th August, 2017.
3. Drivers of motor vehicles entering Arima shall proceed as Vehicular traffic routes follows:
 - (a) from the west, along the Eastern Main Road, north onto Industry Street, east onto Anglican Street, north onto King Street, east onto DeGannes Street, south onto Prince Street, east onto El Carmen Street, proceeding along Columbus Street, south onto Moreno Street and east onto Guanapo Street;
 - (b) from the east, along Guanapo Street, south onto Quesnel Street, continuing west and then south onto Pro Queen Street, or west along Guanapo Street, north onto Thano Street, west onto Columbus Street, north onto Prince Street, west onto DeGannes Street, south onto King Street, west onto Anglican Street, south onto Industry Street and west onto the Eastern Main Road; and
 - (c) from the south, along Cocorite Street, west onto Quesnel Street continuing west onto Pro Queen Street, west onto Robinson Circular, north onto Queen Mary Avenue and west onto the Eastern Main Road.
4. Maxi-taxi drivers proceeding east along the Priority Bus Route shall turn north onto Railway Road, north onto Industry Street, east Priority Bus Route maxi-taxis onto Anglican Street, north along King Street, east onto Sanchez Street, south onto St. Joseph Street and onto the Priority Bus Route maxi-taxi stand.

stand | 5. Main Road maxi-taxi drivers proceeding to Arima shall proceed north onto Industry Street, east along Anglican Street, north onto King Street, east onto Rose Street, north onto St. Joseph Street and onto the Main Road maxi-taxi stand. |

Route buses | 6. Bus drivers proceeding east along the Priority Bus Route shall turn north onto Railway Road, north onto Queen Mary Avenue, west onto John Shaw Avenue and onto the stand on the southern side of John Shaw Avenue, facing west, in front of the Health Centre. |

prohibited | <p>7. Drivers of motor vehicles shall not park or proceed on—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Broadway, between King Street and Raglan Street; (b) Queen Street, between Sorzano Street and Hollis Avenue; (c) Hollis Avenue, between Industry Street and Queen Street; (d) Prince Street, between Sorzano Street and Broadway; (e) Cocorite Street, between Broadway and Quesnel Street; and (f) Woodford Street, between Hollis Avenue and Sanchez Street. |

prohibited | <p>8. Drivers of motor vehicles shall not park on—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Quesnel Street, between Guanapo Street and Pro Queen Street; (b) Moreno Street, between King Street and Columbus Street; (c) Sorzano Street, between King Street and Columbus Street; (d) Sanchez Street, between King Street and Prince Street; (e) King Street, between Hollis Avenue and Sanchez Street; (f) Anglican Street, between Industry Street and King Street; (g) Green Street, between Cocorite Road and King Street; (h) Farfan Street, between Cocorite Road and King Street; (i) Prince Street, between Broadway and Sorzano Street; (j) Raglan Street, between Guanapo Street and Sorzano Street, with the exception of maxi-taxis which have their maxi-taxi stand on this street; and (k) Lopez Street. |
| Bus routes | <p>9. Public Transport Service Corporation bus drivers proceeding to—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Arima from the east, along Guanapo Street, shall proceed west onto Quesnel Street, south onto Pro Queen Street, west onto Robinson Circular, north along Queen Mary Avenue to stop alongside the Arima District Hospital; and |

- (b) Sangre Grande, shall proceed north along Industry Street, east along Anglican Street, north along King Street, east along DeGannes Street, south along Prince Street, east along El Carmen Street onto Columbus Street, south along Moreno Street and east along Guanapo Street.

10. Drivers of taxis shall operate as follows:

Taxi stands

- (a) Port-of-Spain taxis shall operate from the southern side of Broadway, between St. Joseph Street and King Street, facing west;
- (b) Mausica Old Road taxis shall operate from lower King Street, facing north;
- (c) Mt. Pleasant taxis shall operate from higher Prince Street, facing north, on the western side, between Sanchez Street and Church Street;
- (d) Calvary Hill taxis shall operate from higher Woodford Street, on the western side, facing north, between Sanchez Street and Church Street;
- (e) Cumuto and Pinto Road taxis shall operate from Guanapo Street, facing east, on the northern side and Sangre Grande/Valencia taxis shall operate from the southern side in the vicinity of Massy Stores;
- (f) Cocorite Road and La Horquetta taxis shall operate from Cocorite Road, on the western side, facing south, between Maurice Avenue and Quesnel Street; and
- (g) Malabar and Carapo taxis shall operate from Loubon Street, on the southern side, facing west.

11. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police Service and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
