ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(ARIMA BOROUGH DAY CELEBRATIONS) ORDER, 2017

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Arima Borough Day Celebrations) Order, 2017.

2. This Order has effect from 4.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight on Duration Saturday 12th August, 2017.

3. Drivers of motor vehicles entering Arima shall proceed as follows: Vehicular traffic routes

- (a) from the west, along the Eastern Main Road, north onto King Street, along Sanchez Street, north along Prince Street to El Carmen Street, east along Columbus Street to Moreno Street, onto Guanapo Street and onto the Eastern Main Road;
- (b) from the east, along Guanapo Street, south onto Quesnel Street, continuing west and then south onto Pro Queen Street; and
- (c) from the south, along Cocorite Road and west onto Quesnel Street.

4. Maxi-taxi drivers proceeding east along the Priority Bus Route shall turn north onto Railway Road, north onto Industry Street, east along Anglican Street, north along King Street, east onto Sanchez Street, south onto St. Joseph Street and onto the Priority Bus Route maxi-taxi stand. Priority Bus Route maxi-taxis

5. Main Road maxi-taxi drivers proceeding to Arima shall proceed north onto Industry Street, east along Anglican Street, north onto King Street, east onto Rose Street, north onto St. Joseph Street and onto the Main Road maxi-taxi stand. Main Road maxi-taxi stand

6. Bus drivers proceeding east along the Priority Bus Route shall turn north onto Railway Road, north onto Queen Mary Avenue, west onto John Shaw Avenue and onto the stand on the southern side of John Shaw Avenue, facing west, in front of the Arima Health Centre. Priority Bus Route buses

7. Drivers of motor vehicles shall not park or proceed on—
- (a) Queen Street, between Sorzano Street and Hollis Avenue;
 - (b) Hollis Avenue, between King Street and Queen Street;
and
 - (c) Woodford Street, between Hollis Avenue and Green Street.

Parking
prohibited

8. Drivers of motor vehicles shall not park on—
- (a) Cocorite Road, between Broadway and Hollis Avenue;
 - (b) King Street, between Hollis Avenue and Green Street; and
 - (c) Anglican Street, between Industry Street and King Street.

Bus routes

9. Public Transport Service Corporation bus drivers proceeding to—
- (a) Arima from the east, along Guanapo Street, shall proceed west onto Broadway, south onto Cocorite Road to Devenish Street; and
 - (b) Sangre Grande, shall proceed north along King Street, east along Sanchez Street, east along El Carmen Street onto Moreno Street, then east along Guanapo Street and onto the Eastern Main Road.

Maxi-taxi
stands

10. Drivers of maxi-taxis shall operate as follows:
- (a) Sangre Grande maxi-taxis shall remain on the eastern side of Raglan Street, facing south, between Sorzano Street and Guanapo Street; and
 - (b) Main Road and Priority Bus Route maxi-taxis shall remain on their respective stands on St. Joseph Street.

Taxi stands

11. Drivers of taxis shall operate as follows:
- (a) Port-of-Spain, Mt. Pleasant, Calvary, Cumuto, La Horquetta, Sangre Grande/Valencia, Pinto and San Rafael taxis shall operate from their current location;
 - (b) Mausica Old Road taxis shall operate from King Street, facing north; and
 - (c) Malabar and Carapo taxis shall operate from Devenish Street, on the southern side, facing east.

12. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police Service and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
