ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND TRANSPORT UNDER SECTION 65  
OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (ARIMA OLD ROAD) ORDER, 2017

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (Arima Old Road) Citation Order, 2017.
2. This Order takes effect from Monday 20th November, 2017. Commencement
3. A person driving a motor vehicle shall not park on Arima Old Road, from its intersection with the Eastern Main Road to a point <sup>Parking prohibited</sup> sixty metres northwest of the intersection.
4. Any person who contravenes this Order commits an offence and <sup>Offence and</sup> is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding three thousand <sup>penalty</sup> dollars or to imprisonment for three months.
5. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the <sup>Removal and</sup> commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in <sup>impounding of</sup> contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police Service and <sup>vehicles</sup> impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the <sup>unlawfully</sup> Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. <sup>parked</sup>
